BY SHIP

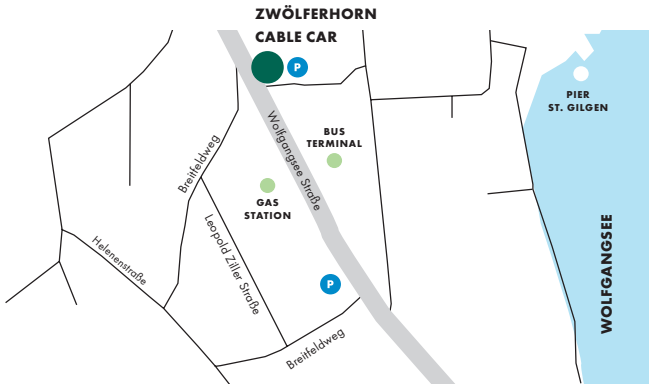
Visit us from a nearby village at the Wolfgangsee by ship. It is just a 5-minute walk from the pier in St. Gilgen to the bottom station building of the Zwölferhorn cable car.

BY BUS

You can comfortably reach our Zwölferhorn cable car by bus. The bus stop (St. Gilgen bus station Raiffeisenplatz) is located right next to the bottom station building.

BY CAR

Coming from Vienna by car, take the Mondsee exit and follow the main road to St. Gilgen. Coming from Munich, exit the motorway at Thalgau towards Hof and then continue to Fuschl and St. Gilgen.

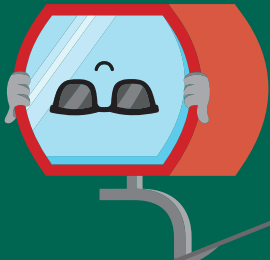
If you feel like it, combine the adventure trail with solving a puzzle and stamp your card at 9 stations.

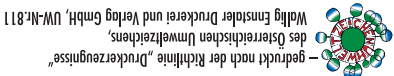

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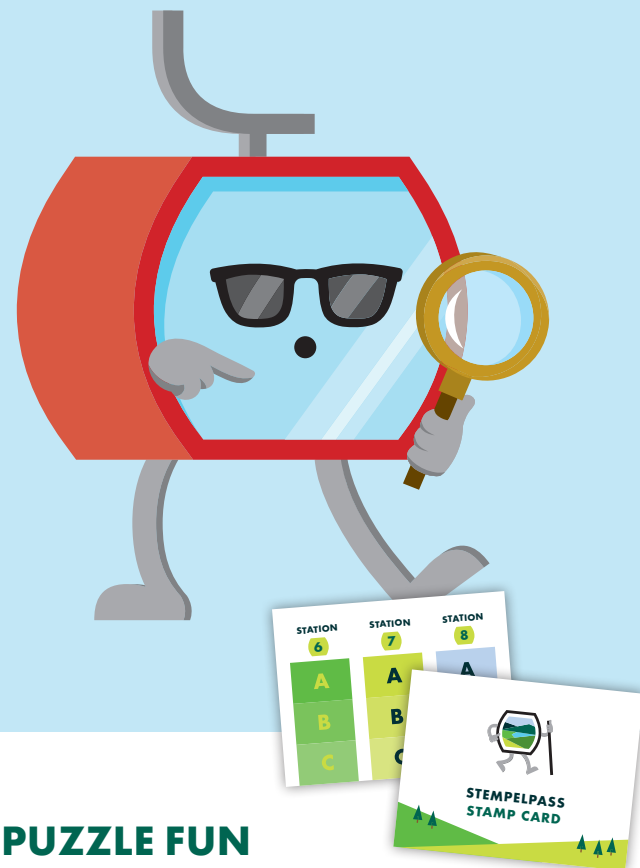
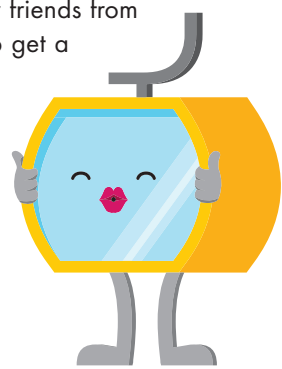
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WELCOME TO THE ZWÖLFER CIRCUIT

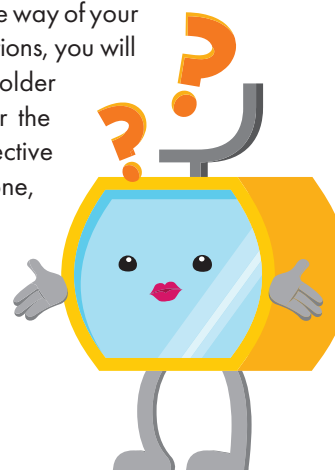
Our 12 stations along the trail offer you an exciting, interactive and playful way to explore how the Zwölferhorn got its name and what natural phenomena can be discovered on the mountain. You will be accompanied by Zwölfi and Zwölfine and their friends from nature. Use this overview map to get a general idea of the tour.

For easy orientation, the individual stations are numbered and signposted accordingly.



PUZZLE FUN

With the Zwölfer circuit stamp card, which you are kindly requested to take with you at station 1, nothing stands in the way of your puzzle fun. At 9 of the 12 stations, you will find exciting questions for older children and a variation for the little ones as well as the respective answers. Choose the right one, mark it on a stamp card and if you have stamped all answers correctly, pick up a little surprise in our Zwölfer shop after completing the circuit. Have fun and, of course, good luck!



WHO CAN ENJOY THE ZWÖLFER CIRCUIT?

Our Zwölfer circuit is a worthwhile excursion for the whole family. Depending on how long you spend at the individual stations, please plan between 2 and 2.5 hours for the circular hike. It is a total of 4 km long, and about every 500 m you will find a station that invites you to interact or simply to linger. These interactions are always divided into two levels of difficulty. At each station you will find a question for toddlers as well as a slightly trickier version.

Are you travelling with a pram? No problem! This is easily possible along the entire circular trail – especially with sportier models.



1 START ZWÖLFER CIRCUIT

The Zwölfer circuit will be explained to you at our historic gondola in the bottom station. You will get an overview of the individual stations and receive the necessary materials for your adventure trail.



2 GONDOLA RIDE

During the ride up the Zwölferhorn you will learn where the Hörndl got its name. If you scan the QR-code on the gondola with your phone, Zwölfi and Zwölfine will tell you a bit more.

3 SUNDIAL

This is where the puzzle fun starts. Pick up your stamp card and answer the first question correctly. This station is all about the day and its 24 hours.

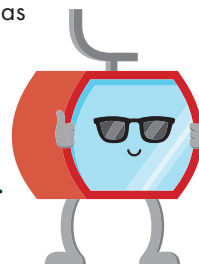
4 WIND FORCE

A windssock and a rotating cylinder give you a feel for the different wind forces.



5 CALENDAR CLOCK

At this station you can read today's date with the help of the sun. We will also tell you why our week has 7 days and where the days of the week got their names.

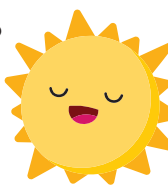


6 STAR CHART

By rotating a disc, you can see that constellations change constantly throughout the year – and yet there are also constellations that are always visible.

7 LIVING SUNDIAL

Here you have to work together and get into position to read the standard time. Sunny also explains how our 12 months got their names – and there's puzzle fun too!



8 MOUNTAIN PANORAMA

Here, Gipfi shows you how many peaks can be seen from the Zwölferhorn and how far your view reaches.

9 ZODIAC SIGNS

Have you ever seen the constellation of your zodiac sign? At this station, Stella will tell you what it looks like and when it is most visible in the sky.

10 POLAR SCOPE

Everyone has heard of it ... the North Star. Find out here why it is so well known and where you can see it.



11 STAR PARK

Where does the sun rise and set in summer and winter and why is the star Sirius so important? All this knowledge is available at this station.

12 PHOTO POINT

The circuit is done. It concludes with a fitting frame for a souvenir photo. Of course, we would be delighted if you shared it with us! @zwoelferhorn
